I have postponed the plebiscite in the 13 provinces of Mindanao & Palawan to Mar. 17, 1977.

When Amb. Dheiga of Libya came to see me at the PICC during the sessions of the Bicameral Budget, he left the impression that unless the Libyans and the PNP get all the 13 provinces, they will terminate the negotiations. He did not use the words 13 provinces. He merely said that, if the result of the plebiscite is not in accordance with the agreement of Dec. 23 (or 24), 1977, they would not proceed with the negotiations.

Today I asked him to come to the Army Parades to first participate in the ratification of the agreements on trade and culture worked out by the First lady, then so I could tell him I wanted to know whether Minister Ali Al Treki had wanted the postponement since the call to a early plebiscite was the major demand of Ali Al Treki. And that was his desire to write to Pres. Fidel V. Ramos. He was talking at moderate from his desk up when he was talking to the First Lady of the Malacanang Palace House,

I called him up to tell him I had definitely postponed the plebiscite to Mar. 17, 1977 upon the suggestion of First Sec. Gen of the Islamic Conference And. Teveltylo and Ass't Sec. Gen. Atiaz.

Mr. Barbero called up at 5:30 AM to tell what he had talked to Minister Ali Al Treki since him wants he is against the plebiscite so there is martial law.

Mr. Barbero has shocked him with the statement that it was he (Ali Al Treki) who originally suggested the early plebiscite and that I intend to go through with it and the regional government will do without the MNTF and the Islamic Conference.

Mr. Barbero feels that the situation is not favorable since Ali Al Treki has not closed the door but action delicate so he is sending Long Castro to Manila to personally report to me and bring copy of the ^{extreme} demands of the MNTF.
Garcia ordered the Armed Forces to act as if the negotiations will fail and prepare for the resumption of fighting.
