HONGKONG MAY 18 (AP) -- THE INTERNATIONAL PRESS INSTITUTE CONDEMNED MONDAY QUOTE THE FLAGRANT AND HIGH HANDED ACTION UNQUOTE OF PHILIPPINE OFFICIALS IN THE DEPORTATION OF TWO CHINESE NEWSPAPER BROTHERS FROM MANILA TO TAIPEI.

THE IPIS NINETEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY CMA WHICH OPENED ITS NINETEEN SEVENTY CONVENTION HERE MONDAY CMA AT THE SAME TIME ASKED NATIO ALIST CHINA TO ACCORD QUINTIN AND RIZAL YUYITUNG QUOTE FAIR AND JUST TREATMENT CMA COMPATIBLE WITH PRINCIPLES OF PRESS FREEDOM AND UNITED NATIONS DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS UNQUOTE

THE ACTION CMA COMING JUST BEFORE THE ASSEMBLY WOUND UP ITS FIRST DAY OF MEETINGS CMA CAME AFTER A MORNING AND AFTERNOON OF MOUNTING CONTROVERSY OVER THE YUYITUNG DEPORTATION NIGHT OF MAY FOURTH
