Aboard the 777

We are off the coast of southern Cebu and will be docking at 5:00 AM to leave for the Dale Pineapple plantation in golf at 6:00 AM. Tee-off time is 7:00 AM. We go to the airfield, an Airbus drive away at 10:00 AM. I take off not later than 11:30 AM for Manila as I must meet with Ambassador Sani, personal representatives of Indonesian Foreign Minister Adam Malik in Malacañang at 4:30 PM, conference with Casa Verde at 5:00 PM on the program for the restructuring of our indebtedness and another conference outside at 6:00 PM.

Quelida and the children will sleep in Dale then return to Manila by boat. I hope to meet them half-way in Iloilo.

Ambassador and Mrs. Byrnes are coming with me in the Tok for tomorrow.

The Ambassador and I have been able to work out some difficulties about the bases and the negotiations to come. So I am instructing the Indonesian to work out all the details.

And the resolution filed by Cong. A. Froy of Zamboanga to request me to declare Admiral Samson and other base officials as persons non grata I have asked to be stopped. Cong. Froy has become a pompous important tyrant according to Mayor Gordon of Albay.
