The Council voted down the ban Marcos resolution by 155 votes against 131. Some of those who pass as friends voted against us: Carlos Sedesma, Angara (Johnny Ponce Enrique's partner). Tilyng Yulo was absent. Pitas Todorov and Elizabeth Chongkran voted by letter but these were not recognized.

Macapagal delivered a better vicious attack against us. So did Rama. But Setero Jaural and Cuderno ~~voted~~ spoke in our favor.

14 were killed in the Israeli kidnapping by Arabs as the German police ambushed the Arabs and their hostages on the way to the airport. I have ordered our entire delegation to be pulled out and denounced the senseless brutality.

Fast night <sup>MANILA</sup> <sup>8:30 AM</sup> Pres Store in Corrales was blown up, by <sup>land</sup> <sup>air</sup> <sup>sea</sup> dynamite, killing one and wounding twenty two. I attach the report.

We lost one helicopter in Palanan, Isabela yesterday morning at 8:30 AM. It crashed into the sea because of engine failure. A Navy boat saved all the occupants. Only one (a co-pilot) was slightly injured.

yesterday I told Ray Johnson of Caterpillar that the American businessmen are worried about their properties and profits while we, the Filipinos, are worried about national survival. Our lives are at stake.

The message I asked them to convey to their American bosses in business and government that we would like them to help us fight the communists. Otherwise we cannot help them.

This is the line we must follow.
