Went to bed at 12:30 last night and woke
up at 5:30 AM. Heli to the coffee plantation at
the small which is about 3,000 feet less high
The housing site of Dalephul is 2,100 feet above
sea level. Unusually warm but a continuing 15-knot
breeze from the east.

Took off for Davao at 9:30 AM. Davao
City at 8:00 AM. Do hostile demonstrators. To
the presence of Brodigo where Messrs. Gonzaga and
Velasco were present. Then to the inauguration of two
city cemented streets. People very enthusiastically
waiting to us and shaking hands, running out of
their houses to see us.

Took off for Zamboanga at 9:30 AM. Unsuccessful
trip but ceiling high. Estimated 15,000 feet. Sailed
at 11:50 AM. Disrupted the temporary tower (various -
travel lost by the 13th Air Force as our R/A tower
was knocked out by the earthquake. Then to the
Pedro Serrano school that collapsed. Built by the
city and inaugurated only last February. Faulty construction -
boundary cement. Covered by television radio. Went to the big
of the fabric with the volunteer workers. He never knew he could run so
fast downstairs. He first fell flat on the floor of his
room and then ran out. So with Jose that she returned
to pick up Sugar the Japanese who was sour because he
had been audited.
