MEMORANDUM

For : The Chairman Price Control Commission

After a series of conferences with jeepney, bus and taxi drivers, together with their leaders and representatives, as well as with the spokesman of the oil executives, and in order to give all parties a codling off period and in order to effect an early lifting of the strike staged by the jeepney drivers, I hereby order that the prices of all oil products be kept at levels obtaining as of January 6, 1971, or before the issuance of an executive order by Mayor Antonio J. Villegas of Manila, increasing the prices of gasoline.

This order shall be temporary and will be good only for seven (7) days, within which period the Price Control Commission, with the help of the Presidential Oil Commission and the Public Service Commission, shall determine the reasonable prices for all oil products, after hearing all the parties interested, notably drivers of public conveyances (taxi, bus and jeppney drivers) or their representatives, representatives of oil refineries, dealers of oil products, service station operators; consumers and car owners.
