On board the 777 on the way to Currimao, Ilocos Norte from Agoo, Ilocos Sur which we left at 11:00 PM MALACANAN PALACE

Dec. 27, 1972

Wednesday

We are leaving a beautiful view of the coast looking over the sea. Had engine trouble (bolt of the rocker arm of the right engine loosened) at about 1:30 PM south of Subic Bay. Arrived off the Hundred Islands at 10:30 AM this morning. Bongbong and Inguelito were already sking around the ship when I went up to the deck. Went to Quezon Island about two miles off, took the helicopter with Bongbong and Inguelito with Bongbong and Inguelito in the other and flew around the string of islands that look like mushrooms on the sea or green swails on top of the blue water. Then skied with Bongbong around the islands. Lunch in the windy island on lobster, crabs, shrimp, ararasip, tinac, arawang and fresh tomatoes.

Gifts for everyone. Meligaying porko bays and wellies. Then left for Agoo at about 3:00 PM Bongbong and Inguelito sking all the way to the ship. Arrived off Agoo at about 4:10 PM. Titchik operation for Inguelito to negotiate ship to shore (PCF to the power boat then carried on a chair to shore).

The nice house at Sta. Rita, Agoo is a house with wide long beach. Cool air, friendly people, isolated from the town and fresh sea food - malaga, arawang (the smallest shrimp) epl, and frogs, marungay - fresh coconuts. Joe Asperino, Bob Brenner, Titchik and Wayne Brown were there.
