Went to bed at 3:00 AM. Ate a full meal at 12:00 PM last night with the rest who fasted the whole day except for half a meal.

Woke up at 8:00 AM. Met Ambassador Urabe who went to Japan to improve the jaded up atmosphere caused by the action of San Jose Reyes' Committee on Foreign Affairs unanimously opposing the Phil Japan Treaty of Amity and Navigation. He says he succeeded partially.

Then played golf 10:30 AM to 2:30 PM at Camp John Hay with Ben and Felix Nieto and Ray Brown, the camp commander.

Lunch at 3:00 PM. Press conference and appointment and induction to office of Gen. Tuabes as Acting Postmaster General and Villason as Director of Telecommunications.

Shower, massage and a nap. Then met the natives: Ilocos Sur leaders. Tony Villamor & Vincent Cristogo on the killings of Crisologo's followers. I called the Zone Commander, JC chief, Pres. Commander and the Governor (Charit Sujan) for tomorrow. Tony & Joe Florento on the banana exportation problem. Sen. Leonardo Perez on the Cagayan Valley problem of subversion. Don Doney and Delegate Diego of Bontoc. Mayor Rodriguez and Ruby Cuaca & Eng. Gomez on mining & natural resources survey. Then dinner at Joe's house up to 1:00 AM.
