It is 'Montezuma', the best Catholic school for girls in the U.S. two and a half hours away from San Francisco by car and half an hour by plane, and this qualifies Ince for Princeton.

Earl Mayo helped locate it. Bob Flanagan helped. He is one of the closest aides of Pres. Nixon and a graduate of Princeton.

And Kakay says it is so beautiful if not more so than any beach resort he knows — "Bazun's and Kyle combined does not match it". It has a high scholastic standard and he can get a 65 year old former teacher living in Monterey at \$3,500 a year to attend to the needs of Ince and escort her when she is allowed out of the school once a month.

And Ince seems to like it as she has always preferred to stay in the U.S. West coast. She is coming back after she visits the school and stops a little. But her classes start Sept. 7th.
