with political leaders.

Although I spent about half an hour
with the Muslim leaders led by Sr. Ismail
Tomaso, Cong. Anic of Sulu, Gov. Princes
Tarlata, Mayor Dianin on the Bangladesh recog-
nition. They were unanimous in recommending
caution in recognizing the new state.
I attach the memo of Sr. Tomaso.
