Finished the paper on the Rightist Revolution and Coup de Tat both for James Lowenstein and Richard Messe of the Fulbright Foreign Relations Committee as well as for our confidential files.
Then met these two Americans.

Received the report of Gov. Sangkila on Sulu. He asks for a military solution to the growing opposition to the government led by the HSA leader Nurullahi "Nur" Misuari. The government troops in some places like Sufak are virtual prisoners in their camps.

I attach the report of the governor as well as the assessment by the Marine Commander, Commodore Rudyard A. Brown. The latter also recommends military action.
So does Regional Director Mahmud.
